

Subject: Registration Tips and FAQs

To help ensure a seamless registration experience next week, please review the following tips and answers to frequently asked questions.

Registration Basics & Advising

- **Where to Register:** Visit the registration portal at go.lehigh.edu/studentregistration.
- **Advising Support:** For advising contact information specific to each college or program, please visit the [Advising Contacts page](#). Course selection information from each college/program is available on the [First Year Student Enrollment Website](#).

Troubleshooting & Technical Help

- **Registration Tutorials:** Watch our [instructional videos](#) if you have not done so already.
- **Webpage Loading Issues:** If the page will not load, try clearing your browser's cookies and cache, using an incognito window, or trying a different browser.
- **Registration Errors:** For an explanation of common error messages, consult our [Error Message FAQ](#).
- **Linked Courses:** Linked sections, such as a combined lecture and lab or recitation, must be added at the same time. Review our [Linked Courses Guide](#).
- **Course Overrides:** Error overrides can only be issued by the academic department offering the course. If you are unable to find an alternative course or section, please contact the course department to discuss your options.

Schedule Planning & Adjustments

- **Incomplete Plan Registration:** If some of your planned courses were not added successfully, you can add additional courses individually, rather than registering entirely from a plan. See this [video tutorial](#) on how to add courses one by one.
- **Pending Transfer Credits:** If you are waiting on transfer credit decisions, go ahead and register for a full-time course load of at least 12 credits for now. You will have ample time to modify your schedule before classes start. If you are uncertain about what to choose, reach out to your program's [advising team](#).
- **Alternate PINs:** You do not need a PIN to register through July 31, 2026. You will get a PIN from your advisor after meeting during orientation and can make additional schedule changes at that time. Your advisor will provide a new PIN for registration each semester. Registration deadlines are noted on the [University's Academic Calendar](#).
